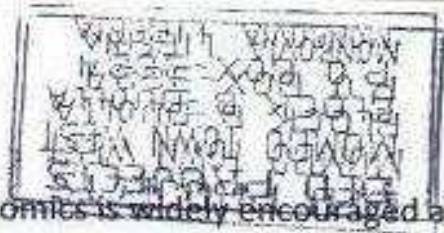
Amazing lot of families are happy that their request have been granted by you and they will not have to pay transportation to distant schools. God bless you.
